

**Before School starts**, make sure to check your child's school bus information online:  
<https://studentbussing.ccrce.ca>



It's important to check your school bus information before September because there could be changes to bus routes from year to year. With BusPlanner, it's easy and quick to check your child's bus information.

Please note:

- In order for a student to be eligible for bus transportation, they must live outside the designated walking distance.
  - Elementary Schools- Students living 1.6 km or less are within walking distance and not eligible for a bus.
  - Middle/High Schools- Students living 2.4 km or less are within walking distance and not eligible for a bus.
- Some of our students have special permission to access buses or bus stops outside of their bus eligibility within CCRCE called, Courtesy Busing. In order to be considered for Courtesy Busing, students must also fit within the Courtesy Busing Protocols. - All student information is pulled from PowerSchool. Please verify your civic address and student date of birth is up-to-date and accurate.
- If you are moving to a new address over the summer months, please update your information in PowerSchool, contact your school (after August 24th) or contact our Transportation staff.



# Check your Child's Bus Information Online in Three Easy Steps

1. Go to <https://studentbussing.ccrce.ca>
2. Click on **Parent Portal**
3. Enter your child's information:
  - Student ID (the 10-digit number you can find on a report card or Power School)
  - Date of Birth
  - Home Street Number
  - School they will attend in September 2020

*\*Don't have your child's Student ID? You can request it by calling your school office after August 24th*
