

Introducing Electronic eReport Cards!

All parents/guardians and students will have access to an electronic eReport Card for all grade 9 - 12 students this school year. This can be accessed through the Student-Parent Portal. Paper report cards will continue to be distributed to those who wish to continue to receive them.

In addition to housing report cards, the Portal also provides parents/guardians with detailed access to student attendance, posted classroom assessment results, current and previous school year grades, and student schedules. The Portal gives you the ability to stay informed about your child's educational program unlike ever before. If you need more information about how to access the Portal please contact the school.

Why are we introducing an eReport Card?

This environmentally friendly option provides direct access to the electronic version of the report card as soon as they become available to students and parents/guardians on the Student-Parent Portal. You no longer need to worry about misplacing your child's report card as all the information will be available on the Portal throughout the school year.

What does the report card look like?

The eReport Card looks slightly different from the paper version you're accustomed to receiving, but other than some formatting changes, you will find all essential information on the eReport Card such as: student and school information, enrolled courses, teacher names, grades, comments, learner profile, and attendance. Below is a sample of the eReport Card.

When will eReport Cards be available on the Portal?

October 10, 2019

After the completion of each reporting period, a message will be posted on the Portal login page prompting students and parents/guardians to access the eReport Card. Our school may also use other means to reach out to you such as email, through postings on the website, or through social media.

Report card distribution dates vary slightly from school to school, so be sure to check for exact dates.

How do I access the eReport Card?

When you log in to the web browser version of the Parent Portal, and if your child is in grade 9 to 12, a new link entitled '**eReport Card**' will appear on the navigation bar on the left side of the page. On the same day that paper report cards are distributed to students, the electronic version of the report card will be available on the Portal. Please note that the **eReport Card** link will only be displayed for students attending a school where the eReport Card is available.


eReport Cards must be accessed using the web browser version of the Portal. If you use the mobile app on your smart phone or mobile device, eReport Cards will not be available on the app.

How can I choose to only receive the eReport Card, and not the printed report card?

You will continue to receive a printed report card unless you choose to only receive the eReport Card.

If you already have a Parent Portal account and wish to only receive the eReport Card, you can do so by either of the following methods:

1. Contact us at the school and inform us that you wish to only receive the online eReport Card.
2. Log in to the Parent Portal, click on the **eReport Card** link, and then check the box indicating that you no longer require a printed copy of the report card since you will access the eReport Cards on the Portal as they become available.

What if I don't currently have a Portal account?

If you do not have a Portal account yet, your first step is to contact the school and we will provide you with the necessary information you need to create your own account. Students and parents have separate login accounts, and therefore do not share the same login account information. Students can request their Portal login information at the school.

How long are eReport Cards available online?

eReport Cards for only the current school year will be available on the Portal, so if you wish to have a permanent copy of the report card for your records, ensure to either print or save the report card before the Portal shuts down in early July.
